FSM Ever 6 Explained For All Schools

The 6-year period - **Ever 6**, is unique to individual students' <u>Free School Meal</u> <u>end dates</u>.

This is when a student has an historic FSM status. They will be classed as Ever 6 FSM for **6 years after their FSM eligibility end date.**

For example, if a student was FSM eligible from 1st September 2018 until 31st October 2020, they will be Ever 6 FSM until 31st October 2026 - 6 years after their FSM end date.

Additionally, any pupil with a start date for FSM eligibility on <u>31st March 2018 until</u> <u>31st March 2023</u> should continue to receive free school meals until the end of the universal credit roll out period.

- 1. Students with a FSM start date in this range <u>will continue</u> to be protected from Universal Credit until the end of their current phase of education.
- This protection will continue until at least <u>March 2025</u> and applies even if the student's circumstances change and they no longer meet the eligibility criteria.
- 3. Ever 6 status can only **start**, after the FSM end date of the student is reached.
